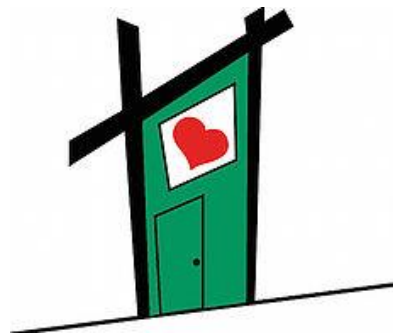


Housing the Homeless Restoring Hope and Faith One Home at a Time

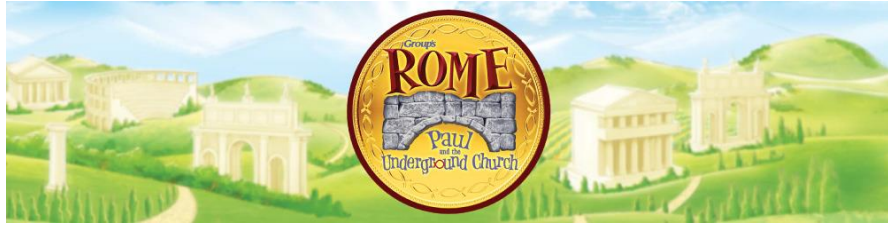
