### Coffee & Conversation October 1: The Gezer Calendar and its Importance in Understanding Scripture

Throughout the Scriptures and especially notable in the structure of Biblical Prophecies, agricultural terms and motifs were often highlighted. Yet, in the present Post Modern era, agricultural terminology has lost much of its significance. The discovery of the Gezer Calendar, which was compiled during the reign of King Solomon (about 1000 BCE), aids in our understanding a number of these planting and harvesting terms and why they were used so effectively by Israelite farmers and understood by the masses. We'll review the farming schedule of the Gezer Calendar and better relate to how this awareness can unlock the intents and visual impressions conveyed and embedded in many Biblical passages. Class will meet at both 10am and 11:15am in the Library.

**REACH Updates!**

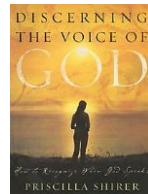

Dr. David Boger was born and reared in Rowan County. He attended the public schools of Salisbury. He received a BS degree from Livingstone College with a major in chemistry and a minor in mathematics, a MS degree from New Mexico Highlands University, and the PhD from the University of New Mexico in Curriculum and Instruction and a minor in chemistry.

Immediately after graduation he accepted a position at the University of North Texas where he taught for 13 years. He returned to North Carolina in 1986 at Fayetteville State University as Assistant Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs; and in 1994 he accepted a position as Dean of the School of Education at NC A&T State University.

In 2001, Dr. Boger accepted the call from the Salem presbytery to become a Commissioned Lay Pastor. He served on the Council of Salem Presbytery for six years, and was Moderator of Salem Presbytery in 2015. He is a member of Trinity Presbyterian Church, Salisbury.
