

SECOND UPDATE

FELLOWSHIP DAY SCHOOL

APRIL 5, 2019

As you know, the Fellowship Day School and Fellowship Presbyterian Church are committed to full transparency with parents and full cooperation with law enforcement relating the matters that first came to our attention on March 7. The only limitations on providing information are the protection of the privacy of the families involved and avoiding any interference with the investigations.

We previously provided a Statement on March 9 that provided all of the information we had at that time, except for the names of the students potentially involved and of the employee. (The name of the employee was provided to the parents during a meeting on March 8). We provided an Update on March 22 that, like the earlier Statement, contained all of the information we knew at that point (again, except for names of the students and employee).

I am attaching the prior Statement and the Update. The Update has been revised slightly to remove the names and contact information for people at the School who are helping us to navigate this difficult situation.

This morning we learned that the employee in question has been arrested. We understand that the Guilford County District Attorney's Office is handling the prosecution. The employee in question has now been terminated as an employee. (As previously noted, the employee was immediately suspended from employment and barred from Church and School grounds as the investigation continued).

This Second Update, together with the original Statement and the first Update, provide all of the information that the School and Church have about this matter at this time (again, except for the names of the students and employee).
